The Libraries provide support for Geographic Information Systems (GIS) through access to specialized software, spatial data resources, and the UNL Geoportal, an ArcGIS server platform for publishing and sharing geospatial data. GIS specialists are available to consult with you on using tools like ArcGIS and StoryMaps, and can help you integrate spatial analysis, mapping, and data visualization into your assignments and research projects.

The research data repository, SANDY (Stewarding Nebraska Data), is a service offered to NU researchers—faculty, staff, and students—by University Libraries. SANDY <u>SANDY.UNL.EDU</u> provides researchers with the opportunity to preserve, share, and discover finalized research datasets that can be shared publicly. UNL Libraries curators will work with you to prepare your data for deposit in SANDY or other data repositories.

Create your accounts to access materials.



The University Libraries is your research partner and works hard to provide access to the materials you need to be successful. Use our library catalog, access more than 300 specialized research databases, or request materials through interlibrary loan and document delivery services. Log in to your Libraries "My Account" to request delivery of UNLowned materials to your office, and create your Interlibrary Loan account to request, track, and manage your borrowed materials. Most articles are delivered electronically within 72 hours.
